



## Region 7 Emergent Literacy Facilitation

The Office of Approaches to Teaching and Professional Learning, collaborating with the Office of Early Learning and School Readiness, has developed this three-part Birth–Age 5 Emergent Literacy series.

The series consists of:

- Part 1 – Introduction to Emergent Literacy & Teaching Early Phonological Awareness (5 hours)
- Part 2 – Developing Oral Language and Vocabulary for Emergent Literacy (7 hours, including 2 hours of fieldwork)
- Part 3 – Building Print Awareness and Interactive Read-Alouds (7 hours, including 2 hours of fieldwork)
