


PBIS Blended Tier I Training




Target Audience:

- District Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports Leadership Team Members
- Building Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports Leadership Team Members


Rule 3301-35-15: The trained positive behavior intervention and supports leadership team will provide professional development to the school or district in accordance with a district developed positive behavior intervention and supports training plan.

Important Information: PBIS Leadership Teams trained prior to 2018 do not need re-trained if they have been implementing PBIS. If PBIS Leadership Teams were trained prior to 2018 and have not been implementing PBIS (or a new PBIS team), they should take the PBIS Tier I training through their SST or ESC.



Requirement: You must attend all three dates to be "trained" and receive a certificate.

- Thursday, February 17, 2022 (8:30 am 3:00 pm)
- Thursday, March 10, 2022 (8:30 am 3:00 pm)
- Wednesday, April 6, 2022 (8:30 am 3:00 pm)



Format: Virtual through Zoom

Description:

The PBIS Blended Tier I training is an 18-hour course provided over a three-day period that includes an introduction to PBIS and six key concept modules. This training will cover the key components of the PBIS Tier I Implementation and is designed to cover preschool through grade 12. The format will also allow teams the necessary time for action planning with the support of a PBIS trainer/coach. You must be available to attend all 3 days in order to attend the training.
